Atlantic City Expressway Highlights



2

- 37,322,951 Toll Paying Traffic to Date – 2.98% Increase from 2018
- Year-to-date Revenue Up 3.8% Over Last Year
- 2019 expected to be highest toll revenue in SJTA’s history - \$82.9M
- Improvements to Amelia Earhart Boulevard and Airport Terminal Road
- Constructed a new ramp lane from Amelia Earhart to County Road 563
- Repaved 18 lane miles along the Expressway (280 total lane miles)
- Beginning a multi-year bridge painting project and culvert rehabilitation work
- Will be installing new LED lighting at Interchanges 2, 4 and 9
- READI – Roadway Environmental Advancement Initiative
- 2020 Northeast Transportation and Wildlife Conference

- **Primary AET Benefits**
 - **Improves Safety**
 - Eliminates stop/go/weaving movements of vehicles
 - **Reduces Congestion**
 - AET is an open road system
 - Reduces emissions/environmentally friendly
 - Toll plaza related backups and accidents eliminated
 - **Avoids Capital Maintenance & Replacement Costs**
 - More cost-effective to maintain
 - 52 year old barrier plazas (2) & ramp tolls (18) – eliminated
 - **Supports Toll Structure Flexibility**
 - Variable pricing to \$.01 increments, inflation-based increases
 - Distance-based pricing
 - Everyone pays their fair share

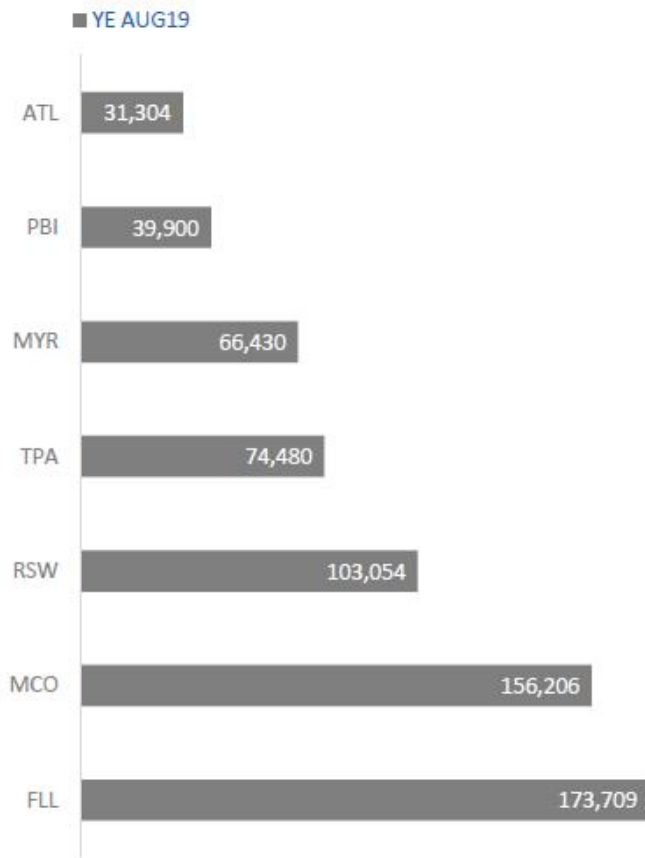
- Location:

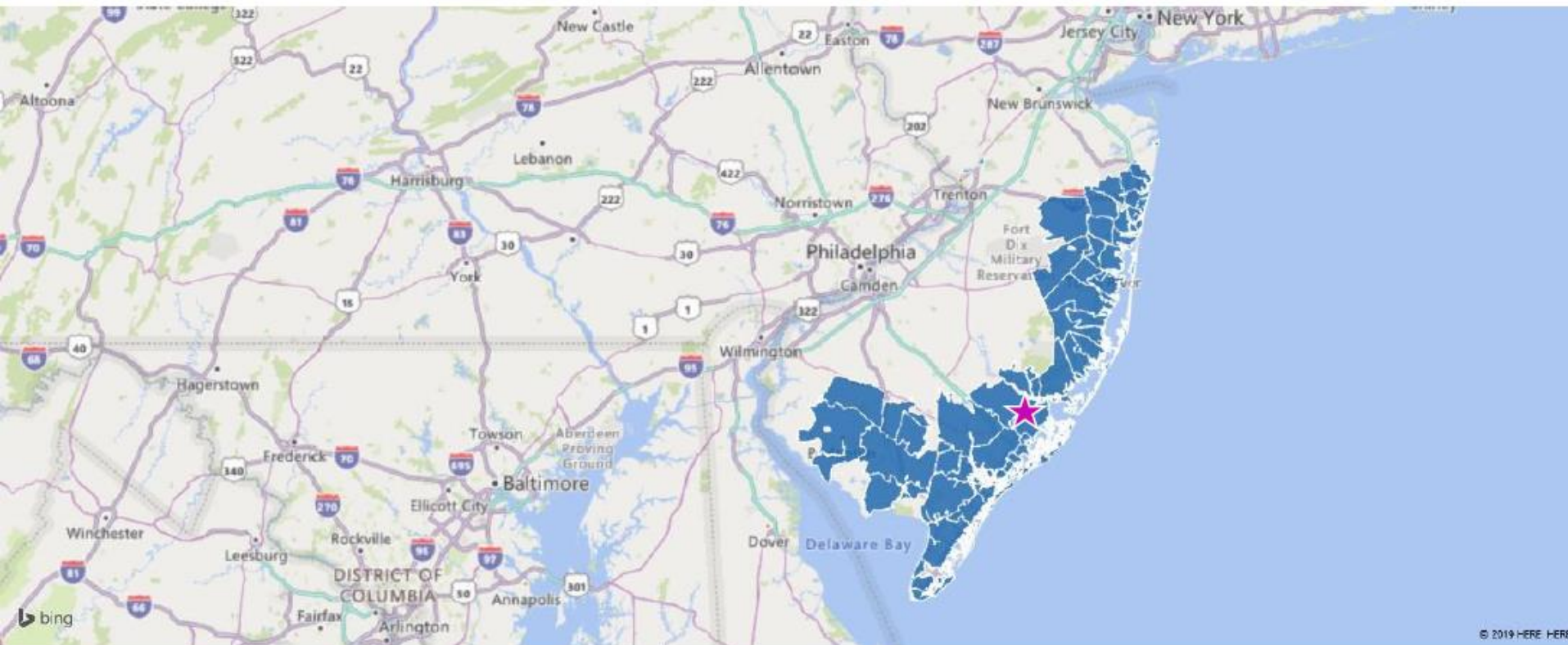
ACY service snapshot - capacity
